Bill 14 received Royal Assent yesterday.  
Owners of properties designated under the Ontario Heritage Act will soon be able to apply to the Province for a rebate of the retail sales tax paid in conjunction with the exterior restoration of their buildings. The maximum amount of the rebate will be \$3,000 per property.

This rebate programme is now in effect and will remain in effect to December 31, 2000.  
More detailed information will be available from the Ontario Ministry of Citizenship Culture in the near future on where and how to apply for the rebate but if you are aware of any recent or upcoming heritage restoration projects please advise the owners to save their receipts.-Stuart



## 2. Heritage Thorold - LACAC

### CCLCA - Thorold héritage



Dear Ontario LACAC and Heritage Committees,

Heritage Thorold is proceeding with plans to increase awareness of the role Thorold played in the War of 1812. This project was originally conceived to educate residents and visitors about the Battle of Beaverdams, which took place in what is now the City of Thorold. But simply telling the story of the battle seemed to present only a minute amount of information about what was a long and complicated conflict. We wanted to tell more of the story and show how and where Thorold fits into the War of 1812 history. Working with our local Historical Society, notable War of 1812 authors and historians, and with help and input from the staff of Fort George in Niagara-on-the-Lake we are developing a display that tells the story of the entire war. Display panels are also being designed for the specific historic War of 1812 locations in Thorold.

We believe that this project could be expanded to include any community involved in the War of 1812. Niagara Falls has identified the importance of the Battle of Lundy's Lane site and are pursuing efforts to recognize it, but again, not the entire story of the war. Any such community would benefit from the spotlighting of its 1812 significance. ( Consider the extent to which Niagara-on-the-Lake's War of 1812 sites have encouraged tourism and benefitted the town ). Furthermore, every participating community would benefit from being part of a network of related sites. The tourism appeal of the Battle of Beaverdams site ( for example ) by itself might be limited, but being placed in context and linked to other significant sites would enhance its attractiveness.

This project is for everyone. Whether the site of a small skirmish or a bloody battle, your community deserves to be recognized as having made early contributions to the history of Canada. If more communities become involved a real trail can be marketed as a tourism attraction within your area. We can eventually follow up this project with a brochure that includes everyone and identifies the trail at information centres throughout Ontario.

Attached is a copy of our Millennium Funding Proposal. Please consider presenting it to your local City Council. There is no time limit. If you can't implement it now, consider it for future plans. We will be happy to provide you with more information at any time.
