ii) Interim Pesticide Application Protocol 1999

City Council Decision - May 5, 1999

6/11 Moved by Councillor Deans, Seconded by Councillor Kolbus

That the Interim Protocol be amended to add the following procedure to deal with localized, specific, problem pest infestations such as aphids and caterpillars, where the recommended action in the Interim Protocol is not sufficient to deal with such an infestation.

- 1. City inspector evaluates the complaint to determine if there is a problem infestation.*
- 2. If the inspector determines that there is a problem infestation, that the complainant be provided with a consent form to be signed by: the adjacent property owner on each side of the complainant's property; and the owners of the three properties directly across the street from the complainant's property.*
- 3. If the complainant obtains all the required signatures, that the appropriate signs be posted as per provincial regulations.*
- 4. If no complaints regarding the potential treatment are received within the specified 24 hours after posting, that the treatment will be applied.*

*That Motion 6/11 be referred to the Community Services and Operations Committee and that the Community Services and Operations Committee be delegated the authority to revise the interim protocol and that the Environmental Advisory Committee and the Urban Forests Citizens Committee be notified of the next meeting. - Carried.
