## **REPORT RECOMMENDATION**

## BACKGROUND

At its meeting of 11 February 1998, Regional Council passed a motion to strike a Social Housing Working Group to assist Regional Council prepare for the transition to regional government administration of social housing in Ottawa-Carleton.

The Working Group will report to Council through the Community Services Committee, which will have responsibility for the policy decisions related to social housing.

The Working Group will be comprised of:

- Four Regional Councillors,
- Four representatives of the housing sector,
- Two social housing residents, and
- Two members of regional staff.

The appointed four Regional Councillors will be responsible for implementing the selection process to recommend the remaining eight members of the Working Group.
