### DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

**That the Corporate Services and Economic Development Committee and Council approve the award of tender 0745-14AA-T1/96 for the supply and delivery of cold mix asphalt to Deschenes Construction (Ontario) Ltd, Ottawa, from the date of award to 31 December 1997 at a unit price of \$35.54 (including taxes) per metric tonne, based on estimated quantities, for a total contract provision of \$53,310.00.**

### RATIONALE

This material is required to temporarily patch paved surfaces such as roads, driveways and sidewalks after excavations are made for water distribution system repairs. These repairs include fixing broken watermains, water services, fire hydrants, valves and appurtenances. Seven firms submitted bids for this tender as shown in Annex A and it is recommended that the tender be awarded to the low bidder, Deschenes Construction (Ontario) Ltd, of Ottawa. This material is purchased as an annual supply commodity and has been tendered by the Supply Management Division.

The cost of materials utilized to reinstate paved surfaces is allocated to various maintenance accounts at the time of issue.

### CONSULTATION

The consultation process is not applicable.

### EXPENDITURE JUSTIFICATION

Cold mix asphalt is required to temporarily repair roads, driveways and sidewalks from excavations performed for emergency repairs to watermains, water services, fire hydrants and valves. Use of this material allows roadways and sidewalks to be safely used until proper reinstatement can take place in the spring.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Material will be purchased into Regional Stores at 951 Clyde Ave through inventory control Account No. 223-51004 and charged against appropriate maintenance, capital and cost recovery accounts at the time of issue. Funds will be available in the 1997 Operating Budget in these accounts.
