DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

That the Corporate Services and Economic Development Committee approve the attendance of two of the following Councillors: A. Cullen, A. Loney, W. Stewart, at the Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO) 1997Conference, to be held in Toronto, Ontario on 24 - 27 August 1997, and that the attending Councillors be approved as the official voting delegates for purposes of this Conference.

BACKGROUND

The 1997 Annual Conference of the Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO) is being held in Toronto, Ontario on 24 - 27 August 1997.

The sum of \$3,500 has been allocated in the 1997 Conferences and Conventions budget guidelines for attendance at this Conference. Costs of attending have been estimated at approximately \$1,720 per person. Based on this estimate, the budget allocation will allow for the attendance of two delegates.

Information on the conference was circulated to Members of Council with a request that those interested in attending advise the Regional Clerk's Department by 25 June 1997. Councillors A. Cullen, A. Loney and W. Stewart expressed an interest in attending.

In addition to attendance at the Conference, AMO has requested registration of the official voting delegates for the conference. All members of the AMO Board of Directors are automatically granted a voting privilege by virtue of holding office on the Board. In addition, the Municipality is alloted 4 voting delegates as the population is over 100,000.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

Funds have been allocated in the 1997 budget to cover appropriate expenses associated with Councillors attending this conference.
