CONTRACT SCOPE INCREASE

DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

That the Corporate Services and Economic Development Committee approve an increase in scope to Contract 93-509 with Miller Paving Ltd., Markham, for the Bank Street South Bridge Rehabilitation, Structure No. 521, in the amount of \$170,000, bringing the revised contract total to \$533,558.

BACKGROUND

On 19 April 1996, Contract 93-509, Bank Street South Bridge Rehabilitation (Structure No. 521), was awarded to Miller Paving Ltd., in the amount of \$389,007.06, including G.S.T. The principle work items entailed concrete repairs, waterproofing, repaving and handrail replacement.

The engineering documents were prepared approximately three years ago, however the rehabilitation was scheduled for construction after opening of the Southeast Transitway. During the rehabilitation larger areas of concrete deck surface and soffit were found to be delaminated than had been estimated from earlier inspections. This resulted in substantial increase in the concrete repair quantities than those identified in the tender.

The construction operations are expected to be completed by the end of August 1996.

CONSULTATION

This work being routine rehabilitation, public notification entailed information signs being posted on both sides of the bridge prior to start of construction operations. No further public consultation is required for the contract variation.

EXPENDITURE JUSTIFICATION

All of the additional works carried out were essential to complete the rehabilitation contract and to ensure extended service life contract.
