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### **DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION**

**That the Corporate Services and Economic Development Committee recommend Council approve the appointment of Councillor Richard Cantin or Councillor Wendy Byrne to the Millennium Steering Committee.**

### **BACKGROUND**

On 24 September 1997, Regional Council approved a grant request to the Millennium Celebrations Steering Committee, to put a structure in place to facilitate and co-ordinate activities and projects for the Region's Millennium Celebration.

As part of their request, the Steering Committee is seeking the appointment of a Regional Councillor to serve as Council's representative on the Steering Committee. This body will co-ordinate, fund and facilitate all Millennium events in the Nation Capital Region.

All Members of Council received a memo dated 17 December 1997, requesting that expressions of interest to serve on the Steering Committee be submitted to the Regional Clerk's Department by 15 January 1998. Councillor R. Cantin has indicated in a memo dated 6 January 1998, that he would like to serve on the Millennium Celebrations Steering Committee. Councillor W. Byrne has also indicated her interest in serving on the Steering Committee.

A public consultation process is not required.
