REPORT RECOMMENDATION

That the Transportation Committee receive this report for information.

BACKGROUND

The South Nepean Transportation and Land Use Survey was commissioned by myself in order to gain insight from residents into the relationship between land use planning and transportation infrastructure across four communities: Barrhaven, Longfields, Davidson Heights and Hearts Desire.

It is evident by the number of new housing developments that these communities are growing. However, infrastructure, such as roads, transit, cycling and pedestrian links, is not keeping up with the increasing population.

The survey was designed to gather the concerns, needs and expectations of residents and businesses, and was carried out in the summer of 1999 by Brain Chegus, a MA candidate in planning at the University of Waterloo.

It is my hope that the results of the survey will aid regional staff and elected officials in prioritizing infrastructure related projects to coincide with the needs of our residents, as well as facilitate policy changes in subdivision agreements in order to support the communities' desire to be better connected with one another.
